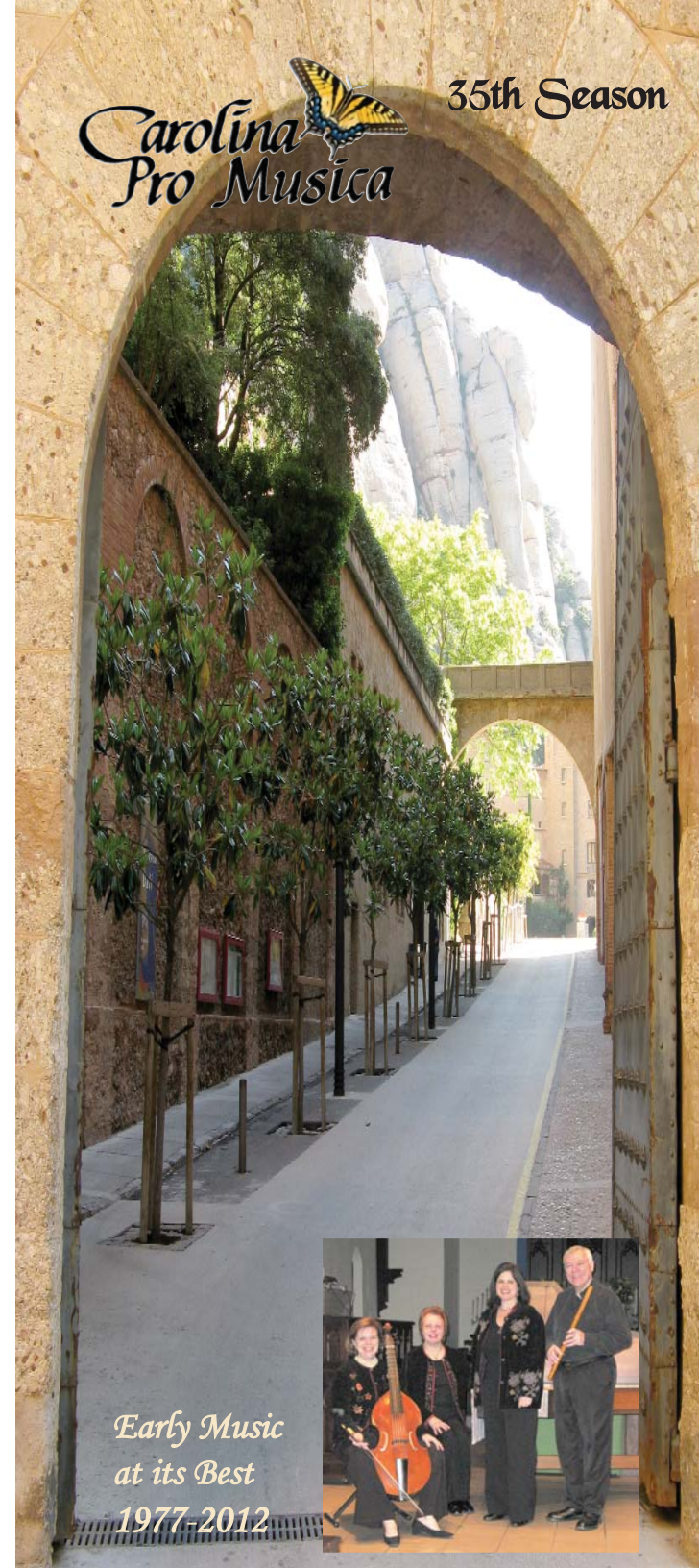

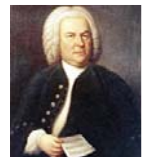
Longings of the Heart: Music of Georgian Times
