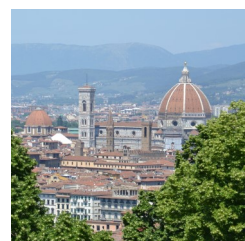
Friday, December 16, 2022 7:30 PM - St. John's Episcopal
